4 THIRTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitu-
6 tion of the State of Alaska relating to
7 public corporations.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Article III, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended by adding a new section to read:

11 SECTION 28. PUBLIC CORPORATIONS. Public corporations may be
12 established by law. A public corporation is governed by a board of
13 directors appointed by the governor. Members of the board of direc-
14 tors are subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the
15 legislature in joint session, and may be removed as provided by law.
16 The board of directors may appoint a principal executive officer when
17 authorized by law, but the appointment shall be subject to the
18 approval of the governor.

19 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
20 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
21 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
22 tion laws of the state.
