5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitu-
6 tion of the State of Alaska relating to
7 public corporations.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. Article III, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended by adding a new section to read:
11 SECTION 28. PUBLIC CORPORATIONS. Public corporations may be
12 established by law. A public corporation is governed by a board of
13 directors appointed by the governor. If required by law, members of
14 the board of directors are subject to confirmation by a majority of
15 the members of the legislature in joint session, and may be removed as
16 provided by law. The annual budget of a public corporation shall be
17 subject to legislative approval if provided by law.
18 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
20 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
21 tion laws of the state.
