EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 62

1 Under the authority of art. III, sec. 23, of the Alaska Constitution,
2 and in accordance with AS 24.08.210, I order the following:

3 * Section 1. FINDINGS. As governor, I find that it would be in the
4 best interests of efficient administration and the health and safety of the
5 public to transfer the fire-service training program from the Department of
6 Education to the Department of Public Safety.

7 * Sec. 2. AS 14.07.020(12) is amended to read:

8 (12) provide educational opportunities in the areas of
9 vocational education and training, and basic education[, AND FIRE-
10 SERVICE TRAINING] to individuals over 16 years of age who are no
11 longer attending school;

12 * Sec. 3. AS 44.27.020(1) is amended to read:

13 (1) administer the state's program of education at the
14 elementary, secondary, and adult levels, including, but not limited
15 to, programs of vocational education and training, vocational reha-
16 bilitation, library services, correspondence courses, and adult basic
17 education, [AND FIRE-SERVICE TRAINING,] but not including degree
18 programs of postsecondary education;

19 * Sec. 4. AS 18.70.020 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 18.70.020. DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY. The
21 Department of Public Safety shall

22 (1) aid in the enforcement of all laws and ordinances and
23 the rules and regulations adopted under AS 18.70.010 -- 18.70.100 and
24 all other laws relating to fires or to fire prevention and protection;
25 [, AND SHALL]

26 (2) encourage the adoption of fire prevention measures by
27 means of education; [, AND SHALL]

28 (3) prepare or have prepared for dissemination information

1 relating to the subject of fire prevention and extinguishment; and

2 (4) administer the state fire-service training program,
3 including the administration of grants for such training.

4 * Sec. 5. This Order takes effect March 15, 1986.
