For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to homesites for veterans."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 38.08 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 38.08.015. HOMESITES FOR VETERANS. A veteran who qualifies for a homesite entry permit under AS 38.08.030 and who complies with the provisions of AS 38.08.060(a)-(d), except AS 38.08.060(a)(3), may not be required to reimburse the state for the costs incurred by the state in surveying and platting undertaken by the state in accordance with this chapter.

\* Sec. 2. AS 38.08.120 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(4) "veteran" means a person honorably discharged from the armed services of the United States who has performed service in the armed forces of the United States for a period of 180 days or more during one or more of the following periods unless a shorter period of service resulted from a service connected injury or disability:
