A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the composition of the Select  
7 Committee on Legislative Ethics."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.20.130(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The committee consists of seven members, in two subcommit-  
11 tees, as follows:

12 (1) the senate subcommittee consists of two [THREE] members  
13 of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate with the  
14 concurrence by roll call vote of two-thirds of the full membership of  
15 the senate; and

16 (2) the house subcommittee consists of two [THREE] members  
17 of the house, appointed by the speaker of the house with the concur-  
18 rence by roll call vote of two-thirds of the full membership of the  
19 house; and

20 (3) three [ONE] public members [MEMBER], who are [IS]  
21 selected by two-thirds of each subcommittee and who are [IS] ratified  
22 by two-thirds of the full membership of the senate and two-thirds of  
23 the full membership of the house, shall serve on both the full commit-  
24 tee and each subcommittee.

26 (c) The [NO MORE THAN TWO] legislative members of each subcom-  
27 mittee may not be members of the same political party or the same  
28 organizational caucus.
