7 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring training in emergency care for
8 teachers certified in the state."
9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
10 * Section 1. AS 14.20.020(b) is amended to read:
11 (b) A person is not eligible for a teacher certificate unless
12 that person has received at least a baccalaureate degree from an
13 institution of higher education accredited by a recognized regional
14 accrediting association or approved by the commissioner and has com-
15 pleted a course in emergency training, including cardiopulmonary
16 resuscitation and first aid. However, this subsection is not applica-
17 ble to
18 (1) persons employed in the state public school system on
19 September 1, 1962;
20 (2) persons issued an emergency certificate during a situa-
21 tion which, in the judgment of the commissioner, requires the tempo-
22 rary issuance of a certificate to a person not otherwise qualified.
23 * Sec. 2. A teacher who holds or has applied for a certificate on the
24 effective date of this Act shall complete emergency training comparable to
25 the training required by AS 14.20.020(b) within two years after the effec-
26 tive date of this Act.
27 * Sec. 3. The amendments made to AS 14.20.020 by sec. 1 of this Act
28 apply to teachers who apply for certification after the effective date of
this Act.
