A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Inmate Education Advisory  
7 Council."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 33.30 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 33.30.400. INMATE EDUCATION ADVISORY COUNCIL ESTABLISHED.  
11 There is created in the Department of Health and Social Services the  
12 Inmate Education Advisory Council to coordinate inmate education  
13 services.

14 Sec. 33.30.410. MEMBERSHIP AND TERM OF OFFICE. The council  
15 consists of five members who are appointed by and serve at the plea-  
16 sure of the governor.

17 Sec. 33.30.420. COMPENSATION. Members of the council receive no  
18 compensation for their services but are entitled to per diem and  
19 travel allowances authorized by law for other boards and commissions.

20 Sec. 33.30.430. DUTIES. The council shall

21 (1) research and make recommendations regarding inmate  
22 education in the state's prisons;

23 (2) coordinate a system of inmate education that is based  
24 on the individual inmate's education level;

25 (3) hire the staff necessary to carry out the provisions of  
26 AS 33.30.400 - 33.30.440; and

27 (4) perform all acts necessary to carry out the purposes of  
28 AS 33.30.400 - 33.30.440.

29 Sec. 33.30.440. DEFINITION. In AS 33.30.400 - 33.30.440

1 "council" means the Inmate Education Advisory Council.
