6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to unlawful obstruction or blocking  
7 of traffic."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.35.140 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (b) A person operating a slow-moving vehicle behind which five  
11 or more vehicles are formed in a line on a roadway posted to prohibit  
12 the obstruction of traffic by slow-moving vehicles, shall turn off the  
13 roadway wherever sufficient area for a safe turn-out exists, in order  
14 to permit the vehicles following to proceed.

15 (c) The commissioner shall designate and post roadways upon  
16 which the obstruction of traffic by slow-moving vehicles is prohibited  
17 by reason of the characteristics of the roadway, traffic volume, or  
18 other conditions.

19 (d) In this section "slow-moving vehicle" means one that is  
20 proceeding at a rate of speed less than the posted speed limit and the  
21 normal flow of traffic at the particular time and place.
