6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing salmon classics."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 05.15.060 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 05.15.060. REGULATIONS. In accordance with the Administra-  
10 tive Procedure Act (AS 44.62), the commissioner of revenue shall adopt  
11 [, NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 7, 1960,] regulations necessary to carry  
12 out this chapter covering, but not limited to

13 (1) the issuance, renewal, and revocation of permits;

14 (2) a method of ascertaining net proceeds, the determina-  
15 tion of items of expense that may be incurred or paid and the limita-  
16 tion of the amount of the items of expense to prevent the proceeds  
17 from the activity permitted from being diverted to noncharitable,  
18 noneducational, nonreligious, or profit-making organizations, indivi-  
19 duals or groups;

20 (3) the immediate revocation of permits if this chapter or  
21 regulations issued under it are violated;

22 (4) the requiring of detailed, sworn, financial reports of  
23 operations from permittees including detailed statements of receipts  
24 and payments;

25 (5) the investigation of permittees and their employees,  
26 including the fingerprinting of those permittees and employees whom  
27 the commissioner considers it advisable to fingerprint;

28 (6) exclusion from participation as a permittee or employee  
29 of a permittee of any person convicted of a felony, a crime involving

1 moral turpitude, or violation of a municipal, state, or federal gamb-  
2 ling law;

3 (7) the method and manner of conducting activity and award-  
4 ing of prizes or awards, and the equipment that may be used;

5 (8) the number of activities that may be held, operated, or  
6 conducted under a permit during a specified period;

7 (9) a method of accounting for receipts and disbursements  
8 including the keeping of records and requirements for the separate  
9 banking of all receipts, and payments by check only;

10 (10) the disposition of funds in possession of a permittee  
11 at the time a permit is surrendered, revoked, or invalidated;

12 (11) restrictions on the participation by employees of the  
13 Department of Fish and Game in the salmon classics;

14 (12) other matters the commissioner considers necessary to  
15 carry out this chapter or protect the best interest of the public.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 05.15.100(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) The commissioner of revenue may issue a permit to a munic-  
18 ipality or qualified organization. The permit gives the municipality  
19 or organization the privilege of conducting bingo, raffles and lot-  
20 teries, ice classics, rain classics, salmon classics, dog mushers'  
21 contests, fish derbies and contests of skill.

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 05.15.180(b) is amended to read:

23 (b) With the exception of raffles, lotteries, rain classics,  
24 salmon classics, and other activities authorized under AS 05.15.100-

25 (b), an [NO] activity may not be licensed under this chapter unless it  
26 existed in the state in substantially the same form and was conducted  
27 in substantially the same manner before January 1, 1959.

28 \* Sec. 4. AS 05.15.210 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

29 (24) "salmon classic" means a game of chance, to be operated

1 and administered by the United Fisherman of Alaska, in which a prize  
2 of money is awarded for the closest guess of the total number of  
3 salmon harvested commercially statewide, as determined by the Depart-  
4 ment of Fish and Game, during a certain period of time.
