A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to designation of the Dillingham to  
7 Aleknagik road."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. PURPOSE. The Wood-Tikchik State Park comprises fully  
10 one-half of the Alaska State Park system. The area is unique in its sharp  
11 contrasts from the steep mountains rising from the 11 deep parallel lakes,  
12 to the forested beaches, islands, and expansive marshes. The park is  
13 becoming increasingly popular to local residents and a rapidly growing  
14 tourist industry. Both subsistence and recreational users depend upon the  
15 access provided by the Dillingham to Aleknagik road. It is therefore the  
16 intent of the legislature to designate the Dillingham to Aleknagik road as  
17 the Gateway to the Wood-Tikchik State Park.

19 Sec. 35.40.025. DILLINGHAM TO ALEKNAGIK ROAD. The road from  
20 Dillingham to Aleknagik is designated the Gateway to the Wood-Tikchik  
21 State Park.
