6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid for school construction  
7 for unhousted students; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.11 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 14.11.102. RETIREMENT OF SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION DEBT FOR  
12 UNHOUSED STUDENTS. (a) During each fiscal year, the state shall  
13 allocate to each municipal school district that qualifies for retire-  
14 ment of school construction debt under AS 14.11.100(a)(5) a portion of  
15 the payments described in that paragraph if the commissioner deter-  
16 mines that

17 (1) the project being funded is required to house students  
18 who would otherwise have to be double shifted or would have to be  
19 housed in portable or relocatable buildings; and

20 (2) the average of the district's local contribution for  
21 operating and capital expenses of education over the past three years  
22 exceeds the equivalent of a three mill levy on the full and true value  
23 of taxable real and personal property in the district, as determined  
24 under AS 14.17.140.

25 (b) If a school construction project meets the requirements of  
26 (a) of this section and the district receives state funding as a grant  
27 for the project, a portion of the debt equal to the amount appropri-  
28 ated may be retired under AS 14.11.100(a)(5).

29 (c) The amount that may be retired under (a) of this section is

1        an amount equal to 80 percent of the payments described in AS 14.11.-  
2        100(a)(5), excluding payments described in (b) of this section.  
3        \* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to July 1, 1984.  
4        \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-  
5        10.070(c).
