A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act repealing taxes on motor fuels."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. FINDINGS. The legislature finds that taxes on motor fuels

9 (1) are obnoxious to motor vehicle operators, impede commerce,
10 hinder transportation, and contribute to the detriment of the general
11 economy;

12 (2) require onerous amounts of record-keeping by jobbers,
13 dealers, consumers, and state employees, including such items as refunds,
14 credits, affidavits, invoices, warrants, books, and records;

15 (3) contribute less than one-half of one percent of the gross
16 annual revenue of the state, and therefore are negligible in an overall
17 sense, while adding up to \$.08 per gallon to consumer fuel costs.
