6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to disclosure of social security
7 numbers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.99 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.99.012. DISCLOSURE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. (a) An
11 agency may not deny a person a right, benefit, or privilege provided
12 by law because of the person's refusal to disclose the person's social
13 security number unless the social security number is requested within
14 a document that pertains to

15 (1) the administration of a tax;

16 (2) general public assistance;

17 (3) a driver's license; or

18 (4) motor vehicle registration.

19 (b) An agency that requests a social security number from a
20 person shall inform that person, on a form that can be retained by the
21 person, of

22 (1) its authority for the solicitation of the social secu-
23 rity number and whether disclosure is mandatory or voluntary;

24 (2) the principal purpose or purposes for which the social
25 security number is intended to be used;

26 (3) the routine uses that may be made of the social securi-
27 ty number; and

28 (4) the effects on the person, if any, of not providing the
29 social security number as requested.

1 (c) An agency shall delete a social security number contained
2 within an active record in its custody except a record that pertains
3 to the administration of a tax, general public assistance, a driver's
4 license, or motor vehicle registration.

5 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1986.
