6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the state to purchase certain
7 products and services from sheltered workshops."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 37.05.265. PURCHASE OF SHELTERED WORKSHOP PRODUCTS AND
11 SERVICES. (a) A state agency shall purchase its products and
12 services from sheltered workshops operated in the state if the
13 products or services are listed on the procurement list established
14 for this purpose by the department and if the products or services are
15 available for delivery in a reasonable time.

16 (b) The department shall determine the market price of the
17 products and services offered for sale to state agencies by sheltered
18 workshops operated in the state. The price must recover for the
19 sheltered workshop the cost of raw materials, labor, overhead, and
20 delivery, without profit. The department shall revise the market
21 price from time to time to account for changing cost factors.

22 (c) The department shall establish and publish a procurement
23 list for products and services provided by the sheltered workshops in
24 the state that the department determines are suitable in quality and
25 price for purchase by state agencies under this section. The depart-
26 ment shall distribute this procurement list to all state agencies.

27 (d) The department shall adopt regulations regarding product and
28 service specifications, delivery requirements, and other matters that
29 are necessary to carry out this section.

2 (3) "sheltered workshop" means an establishment that
3 manufactures products or provides services [A PLACE WHERE MANUFACTURE
4 OR HANDIWORK IS CARRIED ON,] and that [WHICH] is operated by a
5 nonprofit corporation for the primary purpose of providing
6 remunerative employment to handicapped individuals.
