6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the exemption of a telephone or  
7 electric utility from regulation by the Alaska Public  
8 Utilities Commission."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 42.05.711(e) is amended to read:

11 (e) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, an  
12 [ANY] electric or telephone utility that has 250 or fewer subscribers  
13 [DOES NOT GROSS \$50,000 ANNUALLY] is exempt from regulation under this  
14 chapter unless 25 percent of the subscribers petition the commission  
15 for regulation.

17 (f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, an  
18 electric or telephone utility that has from 251 to 750 subscribers  
19 [DOES NOT GROSS \$325,000 ANNUALLY] may elect to be exempt from the  
20 provisions of this chapter, other than AS 42.05.221 - 42.05.281, under  
21 the procedure described in AS 42.05.712.
