A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the herding of fish."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 16.10.135. HERDING FISH BY AIRCRAFT. (a) A person may not
10 knowingly take fish within 24 hours after the fish have been dis-
11 turbed, driven, or herded by aircraft, regardless of whether the
12 person operating the aircraft intended or knew that the aircraft was
13 affecting, or was likely to affect, the fish, and regardless of wheth-
14 er the aircraft was operated in conjunction with the person's fishing
15 operation.

16 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a class B
17 misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not
18 more than 90 days, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.
