7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 09.20.030 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 09.20.030. EXEMPTIONS. A person may claim exemption and  
10 may be excused from service as a juror if it is shown that

11 (1) the person's health, the health or proper care of the  
12 person's family, a permanent physical or mental disability, or other  
13 substantial hardship expected to last more than two years makes it  
14 necessary for the person to be excused;

15 (2) [, OR IF] the person is a judicial officer; or

16 (3) the person has an active license to practice medicine  
17 issued under AS 08.64.
