6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the number of superior court
7 judges in the third judicial district; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court consists
12 of 31 [29] judges, five of whom shall be judges in the first judicial
13 district, three of whom shall be judges in the second judicial dis-
14 trict, 18 [16] of whom shall be judges in the third judicial district,
15 and five of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district. At
16 the time of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill a
17 vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council shall also
18 designate the district in which the appointee is to reside and serve.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
20 10.070(c).
