A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to appointments to the boards of  
fisheries and game."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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\* Section 1. AS 16.05.221 is amended to read:

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Sec. 16.05.221. BOARDS OF FISHERIES AND GAME. (a) For purposes

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of the conservation and development of the fishery resources of the

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state, there is created the Board of Fisheries composed of seven

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members appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a major-

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ity of the members of the legislature in joint session. At least 30

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days before making an appointment to the Board of Fisheries, the

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governor shall publish the names of the proposed appointees in news-

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papers in all sections of the state and shall accept public comment on

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the fitness of the proposed appointees to sit on the Board of Fisher-

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ies. The appointed members shall be residents of the state who are

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knowledgeable about the allocation and use of fisheries resources.

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Members [AND] shall be appointed without regard to political affil-

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iation or geographical location of residence. The commissioner is not

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a member of the Board of Fisheries, but shall be ex officio secretary.

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(b) For purposes of the conservation and development of the game

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resources of the state, there is created a Board of Game composed of

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seven members appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a

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majority of the members of the legislature in joint session. At least

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30 days before making an appointment to the Board of Game, the gover-

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nor shall publish the names of the proposed appointees in newspapers
