alcoholic beverages; and providing for an effective
date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.11.370 is amended by adding a new subsection to
read:

(b) The license of a licensee who violates AS 04.16.172 shall be
suspended for a period of not more than one year.

* Sec. 2. AS 04.16 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.16.172. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS ON SALES OF ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES. (a) A primary source of supply may not sell or ship
alcoholic beverages into the state unless the sale or shipment in-
cludes an invoice from the primary source of supply to a wholesaler
licensed under AS 04.11.160. The invoice must include an account of
the alcoholic beverages sold or shipped and the names and addresses of
the primary source of supply and the wholesaler.

(b) On or before the 10th day of each month, wholesalers and
primary sources of supply shall mail to the Department of Revenue,
postage prepaid, a copy of the invoices covering sales and shipments
during the preceding month.

(c) In this section

(1) "primary source of supply" means the distiller, produc-
er, or owner of the alcoholic beverage at the time it became a market-
able product, and the bottler, prime importer, trademark owner, brand
