14 office of public advocacy in the Department of Administration;

15 * Sec. 2. AS 44.21.420(b) is amended to read:

16 (b) The commissioner of administration may employ attorneys and
17 associate attorneys needed to perform the duties set out in AS 44.21.-
18 410. Attorneys and associate attorneys employed by the commissioner
19 of administration in the office of public advocacy are in the par-
20 tially exempt service under AS 39.25.120.
