A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state contracts for products and
7 services."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.09.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The department may provide for the transportation of pupils
11 who reside a distance from established schools, and in order to accom-
12 plish that purpose may

13 (1) require school districts to enter into contracts with
14 the department for the administration, supervision, operation or
15 subcontracting of the operation of transportation systems for students
16 to and from the schools within their service area if those services
17 are not available from the private sector;

18 (2) require all school districts, transportation contrac-
19 tors and other recipients of state transportation funds to submit to
20 the department an annual report, which includes a financial statement
21 and other operational data required by the department;

22 (3) permit school districts to

23 (A) establish supplementary systems of student trans-
24 portation for students ineligible to utilize transportation
25 facilities paid for by the state,

26 (B) charge fares or fees for the supplementary trans-
27 portation systems, and

28 (C) use local tax funds to pay, in whole or in part,
29 the cost of the supplementary system.

2 (d) A legislative agency or a legislative committee may not
3 contract with a state agency, a municipal government, or a federal
4 agency for products or services available from the private sector.

7 state agency may not contract with another state agency, a municipal

13 available from the private sector.

16 TION. Except as provided in AS 37.05.240(c), this [THIS] chapter does
17 not prevent the department from purchasing through the General Ser-
18 vices Administration as provided by law.

20 Sec. 44.65.010. AUTHORIZATION TO FURNISH SERVICES UNDER CON-
21 TRACT. A state agency or department may make a written agreement or
22 contract with another state agency or department for furnishing neces-
23 sary and authorized special or technical services, including the
24 services of employees, the services of materials, or the services of
25 equipment, if the services are unavailable from the private sector.
26 The actual cost of the services, or the nearest estimate of the cost
27 that is practicable, shall be reimbursed.
