A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to enforcement of commercial motor  
7 vehicle laws."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.32.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 28.32.010. COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTIONS. A  
11 commercial motor vehicle may not be operated after July [JANUARY] 1,  
12 1986 without a certificate of inspection. An owner of a commercial  
13 motor vehicle shall renew a certificate of inspection at least semi-  
14 annually at an official inspection station under AS 28.32.030. The  
15 owner may renew a certificate of inspection at any time during the  
16 office hours of the inspection station. An owner of a commercial  
17 motor vehicle shall display a current sticker of inspection visible  
18 from outside the vehicle in a location determined by the division.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.32.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (b) The commissioner of public safety may appoint personnel  
21 designated by the Department of Commerce and Economic Development to  
22 assist in the enforcement of this chapter.

24 (c) The department may authorize department personnel and  
25 personnel designated by the Department of Commerce and Economic  
26 Development to enforce this section and may adopt procedural regula-  
27 tions necessary to implement this section.

29 (25) operate motor vehicle weighing stations, issue

1 special written permits authorizing the operation of overweight and  
2 oversize vehicles, establish fees for the overweight and oversize  
3 vehicle special permits, enforce and adopt regulations to enforce the  
4 size, weight, and load limitations adopted by the Department of Trans-  
5 portation and Public Facilities under AS 19.10.060, and establish  
6 regulations relating to pilot car services, and designate department  
7 personnel to assist the Department of Public Safety in the enforcement  
8 of AS 28.32 and AS 28.33 [THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE SIZE, WEIGHT, AND  
9 LOAD LIMITATIONS ADOPTED UNDER AS 19.10.060];
