6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to suspended imposition of sen-
7 tence."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.55.085(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) If it appears that there are circumstances in mitigation of
11 the punishment, or that the ends of justice will be served, the court
12 may, in its discretion, suspend the imposition of sentence and may
13 direct that the suspension continue for a period of time, not exceed-
14 ing five years or the maximum term of sentence that [WHICH] may be
15 imposed, whichever is longer, and upon the terms and conditions that
16 [WHICH] the court determines. The court [, AND] shall place the
17 person on probation, under the charge and supervision of the probation
18 officer of the court, during the suspension.
