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HOUSE BILL NO. 655

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IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

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FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

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A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to approval of emergency regulations

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by the governor."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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\* Section 1. AS 44.62.250 is amended to read:

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Sec. 44.62.250. EMERGENCY REGULATIONS. (a) A state agency may

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adopt a regulation or order of repeal [MAY BE ADOPTED] as an emergency

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regulation or order of repeal if

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(1) the [A STATE] agency makes a written finding, includ-

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ing a statement of the facts which constitute the emergency, that the

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adoption of the regulation or order of repeal is necessary for the

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immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or general

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welfare; and

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(2) the governor signs the regulation.

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(b) The requirements of AS 44.62.060 and 44.62.190 - 44.62.210

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do not apply to the initial adoption of emergency regulations; how-

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ever, upon adoption of an emergency regulation the adopting agency

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shall immediately submit a copy of the regulation with the governor's

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signature [IT] to the lieutenant governor for filing and for publica-

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tion in the Alaska Administrative Register, and within five days after

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adoption the agency shall give notice of the adoption in accordance

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with AS 44.62.190(a)(1) - (8). Failure to give the required notice by

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the end of the 10th day automatically repeals the regulation.
