6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driving motor vehicles in the
7 vicinity of the James Dalton Highway."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19.40.210 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 19.40.210. PROHIBITION OF MOTOR [OFF-ROAD] VEHICLES. A
11 person may not drive a motor vehicle, as defined in AS 28.40.100,
12 [OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ARE PROHIBITED] on land within five miles of the
13 right-of-way of the highway. However, this prohibition does not apply
14 to

15 (1) motor [OFF-ROAD] vehicles necessary for oil and gas
16 exploration, development, production, or transportation;

17 (2) [OR TO] a person who holds an interest in land [A
18 MINING CLAIM] in the vicinity of the highway and who must use land
19 within five miles of the right-of-way of the highway to gain access to
20 that person's interest in land; or

21 (3) a motor vehicle used on another highway, road, ease-
22 ment, or other valid right-of-way on land within five miles of the
23 right-of-way of the highway [THE MINING CLAIM].

24 * Sec. 2. AS 19.40.210 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

25 (b) Except as provided in (c) of this section, a person who
26 violates this section is strictly liable and is guilty of a violation
27 as defined in AS 11.81.900 and is punishable under AS 12.55.035.

28 (c) A person who, with criminal negligence, violates this sec-
29 tion is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
