7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the highway between Eklutna and the Palmer-Wasilla inter-  
9 section is a main artery for commercial and residential traffic; and

10 WHEREAS the highway is presently only a two-lane highway; and

11 WHEREAS the latest annual statistics concerning the daily traffic  
12 volume reflect a substantial increase in traffic volume; and

13 WHEREAS the commercial and residential use of this highway is expected  
14 to increase even further; and

15 WHEREAS it will require one to two years to prepare the preliminary  
16 engineering and environmental impact studies in order to obtain federal  
17 assistance;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
19 the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facili-  
20 ties to proceed as expeditiously as possible with the Glen Highway widen-  
21 ing, Eklutna North project.
