7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the United Nations General Assembly has recognized the contri-
9 bution of young people in shaping and designing the future of humanity by
10 proclaiming 1985 to be International Youth Year; and

11 WHEREAS the objectives of International Youth Year are to heighten
12 public awareness of the needs and aspirations of youth; to promote policies
13 and programs that allow youth to be an integral part of social and economic
14 development; and to foster among youth the ideals of peace, and mutual
15 respect, and understanding among the people of this world; and

16 WHEREAS there are over 175,000 young people below 19 years of age in
17 this state; and

18 WHEREAS this state has a wide range of ethnic residents as well as
19 numerous visitors from a wide variety of foreign countries that allow
20 Alaskan youth to experience rich cultural diversification; and

21 WHEREAS the state's commitment to broadening its economic relationship
22 with Pacific Rim nations will result in frequent dialogues between Alaskans
23 and foreign merchants and dignitaries;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
25 Alaskans everywhere to recognize the importance of youth through support of
26 the goals and objectives of International Youth Year.
