7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the nineteenth annual Boys' State will be held June 9 - 15,

1985, at Camp Carroll (Fort Richardson) under the sponsorship of the

American Legion and cooperating organizations; and

WHEREAS this fine annual program is dedicated to increasing the dele-

gates awareness of their future roles in state and local government as well

as promoting interest and knowledge about the operation of our system of

government; and

WHEREAS it is only through an admirable combination of volunteer

effort and the enterprising talents of generous individuals who do not

receive government or taxpayer monetary support that this week-long youth

citizenship exercise known as Boys' State takes place; and

WHEREAS the legislature would like to encourage state and local legis-

lators and other public officials and agencies to volunteer their services

and to provide copies of state publications and materials related to the
