8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the seventeenth annual Girls' State will be held June 2 - 9,  
10 1985, at the Fairbanks University of Alaska campus under the sponsorship of  
11 the American Legion Auxiliary and cooperating organizations; and

WHEREAS this outstanding annual program of the American Legion Auxil-  
13 iary ranks high among the efforts of several Alaskan organizations to bring  
14 to the youth delegates an awareness of their future roles in state and  
15 local government; and

WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Girls' State at the  
17 Fairbanks University of Alaska campus is made possible by an admirable  
18 combination of volunteer service and the free enterprise of generous people  
19 and organizations without placing a financial burden on government or on

WHEREAS it is consistent with these standards for the legislature to
