9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Rule 24 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legisla-  
11 ture is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (e) A committee must hear a bill or resolution and report the  
13 bill from committee within 20 days following written request from the  
14 prime sponsor of the bill. If the bill has not been heard and re-  
15 ported from committee within this time the bill automatically is  
16 referred to the next committee of reference or, if there is no further  
17 committee of reference to the Rules Committee for placement on the  
18 calendar.

19 \* Sec. 2. Rule 39(b) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legisla-  
20 ture is amended to read:

21 (b) FIRST READING. The first reading consists of a reading  
22 aloud by the clerk or secretary of the following information: the  
23 house of origin, the bill number, the sponsor, and the title of the  
24 bill, e.g., "In the House, House Bill No ..., by ..... and .....,  
25 A bill for an Act entitled, ' An Act relating to a code of ethics for  
26 state employees.'" The bill is then referred by the presiding officer  
27 to one or more committees. The house may by a majority vote of the  
28 full membership of the house refer the bill to any other standing or  
29 special committee. A bill may not be referred to more than three

1 committees for consideration.
