7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Department of Environmental Conservation and the Munic-

ipality of Anchorage have investigated pollution levels in Anchorage area

10

rivers and streams; and

11

WHEREAS the department and the municipality have concluded that a

12

level of contamination exists such that the rivers and streams are unsafe

13

for human contact; and

14

WHEREAS many children as well as adults who reside in the Anchorage

15

area come into contact with the rivers and streams for recreation and other

16

purposes; and

17

WHEREAS the municipality intends to immediately post notices near the

18

rivers and streams of the danger to the public arising from the pollution;

19

and

20

WHEREAS there is a need for immediate financial assistance from the

21

state to remove the health hazards caused by the pollution;

22

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is

23

requested to expend funds, not to exceed \$1,000,000 from the disaster

24

relief fund (AS 44.19.048) through the Department of Environmental Conser-

25

vation and the Municipality of Anchorage, to alleviate the effects of the

26

contamination of the rivers and streams in the Anchorage area.
