6 tive Task Force.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the fishing industry plays a vital role in the economy of the
9 state, and Alaska's fisheries resources provide a primary source of recre-
10 ation and nutrition for citizens throughout the state; and

11 WHEREAS the increasing federal intervention into management of fisher-
12 ies resources and the protection of Pacific salmon for future generations
13 are both concerns that the state shares with other West Coast states; and

14 WHEREAS other West Coast states have joined together to form the
15 Pacific Fisheries Legislative Task Force, whose purpose is to consider and
16 forge positions on issues of common concern relating to the West Coast
17 fisheries; and

18 WHEREAS Alaska has been requested to participate in this common
19 effort; and

20 WHEREAS the Pacific Fisheries Legislative Task Force will serve as a
21 clearing house for opinions and issues related to the West Coast fisheries;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the President of
23 the Senate shall appoint two senators, and the Speaker of the House of
24 Representatives shall appoint two representatives, to serve on the Pacific
25 Fisheries Legislative Task Force; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED those appointed as members shall report back to the
27 Second Session of the Fourteenth Alaska State Legislature on the activities
28 of the Pacific Fisheries Legislative Task Force.
