Relating to disposal of state land.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS many residents of the state would like to own their own land;

8 and

9 WHEREAS less than 1.4 percent of land in the state is now owned by

10 individuals; and

11 WHEREAS the Department of Natural Resources offered 221,000 acres to

12 individuals in 1982, 109,000 acres in 1983, and 59,000 acres in 1984; and

13 WHEREAS this yearly halving of acreage is an unacceptable diminution

14 of land disposal;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Department of

16 Natural Resources is requested to dispose of state land to individual

17 Alaskans in the amount of at least 75,000 acres in fiscal year 1986, at

18 least 150,000 acres in fiscal year 1987, and at least 300,000 acres in

19 fiscal year 1988.
