BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Rule 37(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-

11

lature is amended to read:

(a) Any member, group of members or, if introduction of each

13

specific bill is authorized by an affirmative vote of a majority of

14

the full membership of the committee, any [,] standing, special, or

15

joint committee may introduce a bill, subject to the provisions of

16

these Uniform Rules. A bill must be introduced, in proper form as

17

approved by the enrolling secretary of the legislature, with the

18

original and two carbon copies delivered to the chief clerk or

19

secretary. The bill is then assigned a number which it retains

20

through subsequent changes and substitutions. The bill is considered

21

formally introduced when the clerk or secretary reads the heading and

22

title aloud in open session (first reading). Bills may be introduced

23

through the Rules Committees by the governor and the permanent interim

24

committees pursuant to provisions of law.
