Relating to the Governor's budget.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS art. IX, sec. 16, Constitution of the State of Alaska, was adopted by the people of the state on November 2, 1982; and

WHEREAS that section places a limit on the amount of money that may be appropriated for a fiscal year; and

WHEREAS the section also provides that within the appropriation limit, at least one-third shall be reserved for capital projects and loan appropriations; and

WHEREAS the Governor has submitted a proposed budget for fiscal year 1987 that would appropriate a total of \$3,377,326,600 of which less than 22 percent is for capital projects and loan appropriations; and

WHEREAS if federal receipts are deleted from the Governor's proposed budget, less than 17 percent of the money appropriated from the state treasury is appropriated for capital projects and loans;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to resubmit the budget for fiscal year 1987 and comply with art. IX, sec. 16, Constitution of the State of Alaska, by proposing that at least one-third of the proposed expenditures from the state treasury be appropriated for capital projects and loans.
