11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 WHEREAS certain citizens of the state with small children in their
13 care cannot serve as jurors because they cannot afford the day care ex-
14 penses they would incur while serving as jurors; and

15 WHEREAS the quality of the system of justice in the state would be
16 advanced if more persons could serve as jurors; and

17 WHEREAS persons who would otherwise not be able to serve as jurors
18 because they could not afford day care for their children could serve as
19 jurors if they were reimbursed for their day care expenses while serving as
20 jurors;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
22 the Alaska Supreme Court to consider amending Rule 14 of the Alaska Rules
23 Governing the Administration of All Courts to provide that jurors be reim-
24 bursed for the day care expenses incurred by them while serving as jurors.
