10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Rule 23 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legisla-
12 ture is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

13 (g) Committee members and members of the public may attend and
14 participate in a meeting of a standing, special, or joint committee by
15 teleconference. A member in attendance at a meeting of a committee by
16 teleconference may vote by teleconference. The vote shall be recorded
17 in a manner that identifies the member who voted and how that member
18 voted.

19 * Sec. 2. Rule 24(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legisla-
20 ture is amended to read:

21 (a) A committee acts on all bills referred to it and reports its
22 actions and recommendations to the house as soon as practicable.
23 Committee reports must be in writing and the report must be signed by
24 a majority of the members of the committee. The report will note the
25 recommendation of each member signing the report. A member partic-
26 ipating in a committee meeting by teleconference may direct the person
27 who chairs the committee to sign the report for the member and note
28 the recommendation of the member. When the person who chairs the
29 committee signs a report for a member, it shall be noted on the report

1 that the member is participating in the meeting by teleconference and
2 that the person who chairs the committee is signing for that member.
3 * Sec. 3. The amendments proposed by this resolution take effect on
4 convening of the First Session of the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature.
