2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 49

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitu-
6 tion of the State of Alaska relating to
7 appointments to the reapportionment
8 board.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Article VI, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
11 is amended to read:

12 SECTION 8. REAPPORTIONMENT BOARD. The governor shall appoint a
13 reapportionment board to act in an advisory capacity to him. It shall
14 consist of five members, none of whom may be public employees or
15 officials. At least one member each shall be appointed from the
16 Southeastern, Southcentral, Central, and Northwestern regions of the
17 state [SENATE DISTRICTS]. Appointments shall be made on the basis of
18 [WITHOUT REGARD TO] political affiliation, reflecting insofar as
19 feasible the most recent vote for gubernatorial candidates of legally
20 recognized parties. Board members shall be compensated.

21 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
22 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
23 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
24 tion laws of the state.
