8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS opportunities exist in the state for economic development and

10 investment by large out-of-state business; and

WHEREAS these businesses can maximize their investment and development

in the state by using the planning, design, construction, and management

13

expertise of local businesses and people who are familiar with the unique

14

demands of doing business in the state; and

WHEREAS large out-of-state businesses can also maximize their develop-

16

ment and investment in the state by hiring local residents because they are

17

familiar with demands of work in the state; and

WHEREAS the state would benefit from investment and development by

19

large out-of-state businesses if these businesses hire local residents and

20

cooperate in business ventures with local businesses; and

WHEREAS it would be in the state's best interest to encourage and

22

support the investment and development in the state by large out-of-state

23

businesses;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives urges large,

25

out-of-state businesses to consider participating in the economy of the

26

state by investing and developing business in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives encourages large

out-of-state businesses to maximize their investment and development in the

state by cooperating in business ventures with local businesses and by
