6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to criminal trespass."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.46.320 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.46.320. CRIMINAL TRESPASS IN THE FIRST DEGREE. (a) A  
10 person commits the crime of criminal trespass in the first degree if  
11 the person enters or remains unlawfully

12 (1) on land with intent to commit a crime on the land; [OR]

13 (2) in a dwelling; or

14 (3) in a propelled vehicle with intent to commit a crime in  
15 the vehicle.

16 (b) Criminal trespass in the first degree is a class A  
17 misdemeanor.
