A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibited campaign sollicita-  
7 tions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 15.13 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 15.13.119. PROHIBITED CAMPAIGN SOLICITATIONS AND CONTRIBU-  
11 TIONS. (a) A candidate, a group, political party, and the campaign  
12 treasurer of a candidate, a group, or political party may not solicit  
13 or accept a campaign contribution obtained through physical force, job  
14 discrimination, or financial reprisals or the threat of physical  
15 force, job discrimination, or financial reprisals.

16 (b) An employer, including the supervisor of a public employee  
17 of the state or of a municipality of the state, may not request or  
18 encourage an employee to contribute to a candidate, group, political  
19 party, or ballot proposition or question at the place of employment.

20 (c) An individual who solicits an employee for a contribution  
21 shall inform the employee, at the time of the solicitation, of the  
22 right of the employee to refuse to contribute and that the employer  
23 may not take reprisal against the employee for the failure to con-  
24 tribute.

25 \* Sec. 2. AS 15.13.120 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

26 (i) A person who violates AS 15.13.119 is guilty of a class C  
27 felony. A person who knowingly contributes or receives an illegal  
28 contribution is guilty of a class A misdemeanor and shall be fined an  
29 amount equal to four times the amount of the illegal contribution.
