A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the Capital Projects Advisory  
7 Commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 35 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 35. CAPITAL PROJECTS ADVISORY COMMISSION.

11 Sec. 35.35.010. CREATION. There is created the Capital Projects  
12 Advisory Commission.

13 Sec. 35.35.020. COMPOSITION AND APPOINTMENT. The commission  
14 consists of 16 members as follows: four employees or officials of the  
15 executive branch appointed by the governor, two members of the house  
16 of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house, two members  
17 of the senate appointed by the president of the senate, and eight  
18 members of the public not otherwise employed by the state. The gover-  
19 nor shall appoint four of the public members, one of whom shall be a  
20 local public official. The speaker of the house and the president of  
21 the senate jointly shall appoint four of the public members, one of  
22 whom shall be a local public official.

23 Sec. 35.35.030. TERMS. Legislative members serve on the commis-  
24 sion for the remainder of the term for which they have been elected.  
25 Members of the commission from the executive branch serve at the  
26 governor's pleasure. Public members serve staggered terms of six  
27 years. A vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original  
28 appointment. A person appointed to replace a public member shall  
29 serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Each member serves

1 until a successor is appointed.

2 Sec. 35.35.040. CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMISSION. The members of  
3 the commission shall elect one of the members to chair the commission.

4 Sec. 35.35.050. COMPENSATION. Members of the commission serve  
5 without compensation but are entitled to per diem and travel expenses  
6 authorized for boards and commissions under AS 39.20.180.

7 Sec. 35.35.060. DUTIES. (a) The commission shall conduct  
8 statewide public hearings to ascertain the opinions of citizens of the  
9 state on the need for capital projects.

10 (b) The commission shall report its findings and recommendations  
11 for capital projects to the governor and the legislature no later than  
12 January 30 of each year.

13 Sec. 35.35.070. DEFINITION. In this chapter "commission" means  
14 the Capital Projects Advisory Commission.
