A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act imposing a limit on applications for state
7 employment by current state employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 39.25.157. LIMITATION ON APPLICATIONS. (a) A person
11 appointed to a permanent full-time position in the classified service
12 may submit employment applications for no more than three job classes
13 in the classified service. The employee may withdraw an application
14 for one job class and apply for a different job class. However, the
15 employee may not be an applicant for more than three job classes at
16 any time.

17 (b) When a person is appointed to a full-time position in the
18 classified service, the division of personnel shall notify the person
19 of the requirements of (a) of this section and advise the person that
20 the division will remove the person's name from the eligible lists for
21 all job classes when the person is appointed to permanent status
22 unless the person responds within a stated time.

23 * Sec. 2. The division of personnel shall advise probationary and
24 permanent full-time employees in the classified service of the requirements
25 of AS 39.25.157. A permanent full-time employee who has applied for more
26 than three job classes on the effective date of this Act shall select the
27 job classes for which the person wishes to remain as an applicant and shall
28 advise the division of personnel of the choice. The division shall remove
29 the person's name from eligible lists for all other job classes. If the

1 person fails to advise the division, then the division shall remove the
2 person's name from eligible lists for all job classes.

3 * Sec. 3. Nothing in this Act modifies or terminates a collective
4 bargaining agreement in effect on the effective date of this Act.
