6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bribery and political campaign
7 contributions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.56.100(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person commits the crime of bribery if the person confers,
11 offers to confer, or agrees to confer a benefit upon a public servant
12 with the intent to influence the public servant's vote, [OPINION,
13 JUDGMENT,] action, decision, or exercise of official discretion.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 11.56.110(a) is amended to read:

15 (a) A public servant commits the crime of receiving a bribe if
16 the public servant

17 (1) solicits a benefit with the intent that the public
18 servant's vote, [OPINION, JUDGMENT,] action, decision, or exercise of
19 discretion as a public servant will be influenced; or

20 (2) accepts or agrees to accept a benefit upon an agreement
21 or understanding that the public servant's vote, [OPINION, JUDGMENT,]
22 action, decision, or exercise of discretion as a public servant will
23 be influenced.

29 DANCE WITH AS 15.13;

1 (2)] concurrence in official action in the cause of legiti-
2 mate compromise between public servants; or
3 (2) [(3)] support, including a vote, solicited by a public
4 servant or offered by any person in an election.
