A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act setting a maximum cost for salaries and
7 benefits for state employees and for certificated
8 employees of regional educational attendance areas;
9 prohibiting the use of state revenue to fund
10 increases in compensation for employees of school
11 boards; and providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 14.17.226. LIMITATION ON USE OF STATE FUNDS. A school
15 board may not use funds provided under this chapter to increase
16 compensation for a position from the cost of compensation that was in
17 effect on January 1, 1985.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 Sec. 14.20.553. LIMITATION ON AGREEMENTS. (a) For each posi-
20 tion covered by a negotiated agreement to which a regional educational
21 attendance area is a party, the negotiated agreement may not increase
22 the cost to the regional educational attendance area of compensation
23 for the position from the cost of the compensation in effect for that
24 position on January 1, 1985.

25 (b) For each position covered by a negotiated agreement to which
26 a school board other than a regional educational attendance area is a
27 party, the negotiated agreement may not increase the cost to the
28 school board of compensation for the position from the cost of the
29 compensation in effect for that position on January 1, 1985, unless

1 the school board obtains funding for the increase from revenue other
2 than state revenue.

3 (c) In this section "compensation" includes wages and benefits
4 subject to negotiation.

5 * Sec. 3. AS 23.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

6 Sec. 23.40.075. LIMITATION ON AGREEMENTS. For each position
7 covered by a negotiated agreement, the negotiated agreement may not
8 increase the cost to the state of wages and benefits subject to nego-
9 tiation from the cost of those wages and benefits in effect for that
10 position on January 1, 1985.

11 * Sec. 4. AS 39.27.011 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (d) The monthly basic salary for a position covered under (a) of
13 this section for years after 1985 may not exceed the monthly basic
14 salary in effect for that position on January 1, 1985. This limit
15 applies to positions held by employees entitled to receive salaries
16 comparable to the salaries established in (a) of this section. The
17 board of regents of the University of Alaska may not approve compen-
18 sation for a position for years after 1985 that exceeds the compen-
19 sation for the position on January 1, 1985.

20 * Sec. 5. Nothing in this Act terminates or modifies a collective
21 bargaining agreement in existence on the effective date of secs. 1 - 5 of
22 this Act.

23 * Sec. 6. AS 14.17.226, AS 14.20.553, AS 23.40.075, and AS 39.27.011(d)
24 are repealed.

25 * Sec. 7. Section 6 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1990.

26 * Sec. 8. Sections 1 - 5 of this Act take effect immediately in accor-
27 dance with AS 01.10.070(c).
