A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$166,001,000 for the
8 purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
9 for water, sewer, and solid waste management projects
10 in the state; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
13 for water, sewer, and solid waste management projects in the state, general
14 obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than
15 \$166,001,000 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit, and
16 resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal of and
17 interest and redemption premium, if any, on the bonds. The bonds shall be
18 issued under AS 37.15 as it exists at the time of issuance.

19 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act
20 is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, a special fund of the
21 state to be known as the "1986 Water, Sewer, and Solid Waste Management
22 Fund" shall be established, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the
23 sale of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act except for accrued inter-
24 est and premiums.

25 * Sec. 3. The amount of \$136,751,000 is appropriated from the "1986
26 Water, Sewer, and Solid Waste Management Fund" to the Department of Admin-
27 istration for grants under AS 37.05.315 to the following municipalities for
28 the following projects:

24 (b) The appropriations for projects made in this section may be
25 reappropriated among the projects by law.

26 * Sec. 5. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
27 voters of the state, the amount of \$581,000 or as much of that amount as is
28 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
29 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay

1 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
2 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this sec-
3 tion shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale
4 of the bonds authorized by this Act.

5 * Sec. 6. The amount withdrawn from the public facility planning fund
6 for the purpose of advance planning for the improvements financed under
7 this Act shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds of the sale of
8 bonds authorized by this Act.

9 * Sec. 7. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
10 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the
11 next general election and shall read substantially as follows:

12 Proposition

13 State General Obligation Water, Sewer, and
14 Solid Waste Management Bonds \$166,001,000

15 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation
16 bonds in the principal amount of not more than
17 \$166,001,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of capital
18 improvements for water, sewer, and solid waste management?
