6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to protection of natural range-

land."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. The legislature finds that there is a substantial public
10 purpose in the protection of existing naturally occurring rangeland and for
11 the establishment of state owned or acquired land valuable for grazing as
12 state grazing preserves for the perpetuation of personal, commercial, and
13 other beneficial uses of the resources under the principles of multiple-use
14 and sustained-yield management. In this section, "naturally occurring
15 rangeland" means state land where cattle, sheep, or reindeer are grazing
16 or may graze under lease or permit of the commissioner of natural
17 resources.

18 * Sec. 2. The commissioner of natural resources shall report to the
19 Second Session of the Fifteenth State Legislature within the first 10 days
20 of the session on state land recommended for protection as state grazing
21 preserves.
