6 For an Act entitled: "An Act allowing officers and employees of the state  
7 to take January 15, Martin Luther King Day, as a  
8 legal holiday in place of another legal holiday."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
11 read:

12 (b) An officer or employee of the state may substitute Martin  
13 Luther King Day as a legal holiday from state employment for a legal  
14 holiday listed in (a) of this section that the officer or employee is  
15 otherwise entitled to take as a legal holiday from state employment.
