3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the eligible age for service in
7 the militia of the state; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 26.05.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 26.05.010. ALASKA MILITIA ESTABLISHED. (a) The militia of
12 the state consists of all able-bodied citizens of the United States
13 and all other able-bodied persons who have declared their intention to
14 become citizens of the United States, who reside in the state, and who
15 are at least [BETWEEN THE AGES OF] 17 [AND 59] years of age, [INCLU-
16 SIVE,] and who are eligible for military service under the laws of the
17 United States or this state.

18 (b) The militia is divided into two classes:

19 (1) the organized militia, consisting of the Alaska Nation-
20 al Guard, the Alaska Naval Militia, and the Alaska State Militia, and
21 (2) the unorganized militia, consisting of all qualified
22 persons available for service but not serving in the organized mili-
23 tia.

24 (c) The Alaska National Guard, the Alaska Naval Militia, and the
25 unorganized militia consist of persons qualified under this section
26 who are under 60 years of age. The adjutant general may, by regula-
27 tion, prescribe the maximum age for eligibility in the Alaska State
28 Militia.

29 * Sec. 2. AS 26.23.230(7) is amended to read:

1 (7) "unorganized militia" means all [ABLE-BODIED] persons
2 comprising that component of the militia of the state, as described in
3 AS 26.05.010 [BETWEEN THE AGES OF 17 AND 59 YEARS, INCLUSIVE, WHO
4 RESIDE IN THE STATE].

5 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
6 10.070(c).
